## New Board Elected at AGM: Full Complement of Directors Now in Place

**June 23, 2010, Mississauga, Ontario** – At its June 10 annual general meeting, held in Halifax, N.S., members of the Canadian Supply Chain Sector Council elected a new lineup of directors, including five new members. The Board now includes 20 directors, two observers and one *ex officio* member. With this expansion from its previous total of 18 members, the Board is now at full membership as defined by the Council's by-laws.

Dwayne Hihn (President of Manitoulin Global Forwarding) was elected as Chair, succeeding Don Borsk (COO of Metro Retail Supply Chain Solutions) in that role. Mr. Borsk served as Chair of the Council since its inception in 2006 and will remain on the Board for two years as Past Chair. Both Mr. Borsk and Mr. Hihn were integral to the establishment of the Council, following on their involvement in the 2004/2005 sector study that recommended the creation of a Council-like organization. After his election, Mr. Hihn said, "It is an honour to be selected to serve as the Chair of the Canadian Supply Chain Sector Council. The needs of employers, along with those of current and future employees, in the supply chain sector are constantly evolving. The CSCSC, working together with all of our partners, provides a great opportunity to unite our sector to ensure we have an energized, talented and sustainable labour force today and in the future."

In moving on from his role as Chair, Mr. Borsk summed up the Council's purpose and evolution: "This Canadian Supply Chain Sector Council has been in existence for four years. It has become a real value generator for the industry in the field of creating meaningful human resources initiatives. It grew out of a major study, completed some five years ago, that pointed to the need for an objective group of supply chain professionals to collaborate on the HR issues facing our industry." Taking stock of his tenure, Mr. Borsk continued, "I have been fortunate and honoured to have chaired this council since its inception. The CSCSC Board, our motivated and hard-working staff led by Kevin Maynard, our association stakeholders, our Government of Canada sponsorship, our large number of industry volunteers, and numerous educational institutions have all combined to produce this success – a true example of the collaboration that defines how we need to work across the supply chain. I leave the Chair's position with thanks and gratitude to all those that have made my involvement so enjoyable. I am convinced that we will all continue to use our sector council to enhance the careers and viability of our profession."

Filling the gap on the Executive Committee originating from Mr. Hihn's elevation to Chair, David McCormick (Managing Partner and President of Pivotal ACTION FORCE Industrial Staffing Solutions) was elected as a Vice Chair. He joins Darren Christle (Executive Director, Motor Carrier Division, Manitoba Infrastructure and Transportation) and Maria Lindenberg (Vice President, Procurement, Chevron Global Downstream LLC), who will continue to serve the supply chain sector as Vice Chairs of the Council.
